What can I donate?

Can I donate used items?

We can only accept new, unopened items. This is to protect the health and safety of our patients. We can, however, accept very gently used, non-violent, child-friendly DVD movies and video games.

Are there any items that I should not donate?

Due to health and safety regulations and the welfare of our patients, we cannot accept the following items.

- Used stuffed animals
- Latex balloons
- Candles
- Sharp instruments
- Toy guns
- Items that may be frightening to a child
- Religious affiliated items
