

HOW TO COMPLETE YOUR DRUG SCREEN

Memorial requires all students to complete a drug screen prior to the start of their affiliation with the hospital. Drug screens must be completed within 45 days of beginning Applied Learning Experiences at Memorial, however we urge you to complete this at least two weeks prior to your start date. In Savannah, drug screens may be completed at the two Memorial locations listed on this page. All drug screens are walk-in, and you will be charged the student fee of \$25. Results will be reported directly to the student affiliations office. Please note that all students completing an Applied Learning Experience with Memorial are subject to random drug testing.

OUT OF AREA STUDENTS: If you are unable to complete the drug screen in Savannah, you can submit results of a drug screen performed at your local lab as long as it includes the following tests. Lab Corp typically provides this service. Go to www.labcorp.com to find a lab in your area and have results sent to student@memorialhealth.com at least 10 days prior to starting your internship. Test required are:

- Cocaine Metabolite
- Benzodiazepines
- Amphetamines
- Phencyclidines
- Marijuana Metabolite
- Methadone
- Methqualone
- Barbiturates
- Opiates
- Propoxyphenes Metabolites
